First of all, the **All Member Show**, is hung Mon. March 2 between 9 and 10 a.m., if you cannot absolutely make it at that time, please let me know. I am sure I can help out. We don't leave at 10, we have to hang the items.

Either before arriving, or when you get there, we need forms filled out. The Hold Harmless for the Art League and the Hold Harmless for the Community Center. The other form is the information about you, how to get a hold of you and your paintings, which we attach to the back of your art. Take down for this show is Mar 31, all day.

This show is FREE, you can bring 2-3 pieces. It is a chance for you to show what you've done. It does have to be something within the last 3 years, and it does have to be in hanging form. (WITH WIRED BACKS TO HANG). So take advantage of the free hanging and bring your art.

Next is the **Juried All Member Show**: This is a \$25 fee. All the same forms have to be filled out, so if you did it once, we will have that in our book, no need to do it again. If you have a form that says All Member and need Juried, just add that to the top and use it for the Juried.

These art pieces will be judged Mar 2, during our meeting. So you need to drop them off at the art room in the community center between 4:30 and 6 p.m. we will not accept anything after 6, so don't wait.

This show is also taken down on March 31, anytime during the day. Sign them out.

At our break, in the meeting, we will have the juror come in and explain their judging.

Our **awards night** is Wed. March 18. 6-8. With awards given out at 7 pm. We will be giving money and ribbons. This is a DESSERT Reception. Anyone interested in baking or bringing, please do. We rely on our members to help contribute to our table. Thanks in advance!
