Jackie's current work is abstract. She identifies with the artistic motivations of the Abstract Impressionist movement, viewing art as an expression of what wants and needs to come forth. Through the use of a variety of tools and techniques, she then further develops composition, shape, line and color in layers, working primarily with paint, ink and glazing mediums.

She has been an artist for most of her life, and studied drawing and painting in Chicago, as well as at the Scottsdale Artist School and Brio Fine Arts.



The painting was a 12 x 24 semi-abstract oil; the poem was a humorous rhyme about a little boy who gathered "wondrous things" and stuck them into his pocket, where ultimately, they ended up in his mom's washing machine.

The painting was included in an exhibit at the Community Center. It sold to some people who were visiting in Fountain Hills. Off it went, with a copy of the poem (all rights reserved), back to Michigan.

Eventually, Claudia decided that the poem would make a cute children's book. She lengthened it into a story, with plans to illustrate it herself. Like many things, it sat on a shelf, gathering dust for years.

Then, four years ago, her sister Donna (who is also an artist) began creating digital artwork. Just for fun, one day, she sent Claudia a piece that she had done of a praying mantis. It won Claudia's heart, and she asked Donna if she would like to illustrate "Johnny's Pockets." After hours and hours of work, and sometimes "hair-pulling," Johnny was born in e-book form on Amazon's KDP (Kindle-Direct-Publishing) on Dec. 26, 2018, and as a softcover (book in hand!! Hooray!!) on Jan. 16, 2019.
